The Salvation Ride is a fun, outdoor event that supports vital Salvation Army services in the Sheboygan area. With five beautiful routes ranging from 10 to 100 miles and a host of ride-enhancing features, the Salvation Ride is one of Wisconsin's best cycling events.



THE SALVATION ARMY

For more than 120 years, The Salvation Army Sheboygan has been a beacon of help and hope for the hungry, the homeless and the hurting, serving thousands in need each year.

In 2018, the Emergency Lodge provided over 10,000 nights of shelter to more than 300 homeless neighbors, a third of whom were children. The food pantry assists approximately 700 people each month, providing vital food, household and toiletry items. The Salvation Army also offers a variety of supportive services including utility assistance, steel-toed work boots, spiritual support, clothing, furniture, youth programs, and seasonal programs like Coats for Kids and the Christmas Toy Shoppe.

ROUTES

Beginning at King Park and heading south along the scenic shores of Lake Michigan, the Ride offers five route options - 10, 25, 50, 62.5 and 100 miles.

Avoid lines the morning of the Ride with early check-in, available from 4pm - 6pm on Friday, July 5 at the King Park event site.

Ride starts at 7:30 a.m.

25 and 10 Mile Riders:

Check-in starts at 8:30 a.m.

Ride starts at 9:30 a.m.

The Ride will take place rain or shine.
